

























The museum building was built in 1894 as the Municipality building. Visited by the Great Leader Atatürk on December 20, 1930, the building has been serving as the Directorate of Kırklareli Museum since 1994.

Museum's exhibition consists of three sections. Embalmed animals representing the species that are currently living and has lived in our region are exhibited in the Nature Hall on the ground floor In the main exhibition hall on the first floor of the museum, ethnographic artefacts consisting of local clothes, handmade products, jewelry and weapons belonging to the Kırklareli region, together with the artefacts unearthed from the excavations of the Aşağıpınar, Kanlıgeçit, Demirköy Foundry and Vize Ancient Theater, Düğüncülü, Dolhan and Yündolan Tumuli and coins from Hellenistic, Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman Periods belonging to the coin collection are exhibited.





This is the most detailed "Cavalry" scene obtained in Thrace. A Thracian Cavalry, probably returned from or about to go to an expedition, making a wish at the altar under a sacred tree or making a visit of gratitude is depicted.
