
















The first museum activities in Sinop began in 1921 with the collection of artefacts from the vicinity of Sinop. In 1945, the artefacts in the Pervane Madrasa were roughly classified and it was turned into a museum and in 1970, the new museum building was completed and put into service. The museum, which was temporarily closed in 2001 due to the restoration and new arrangement-exhibition works, was re-opened in April 2006.



The Exhibition Halls consist of The Small Finds Hall, the Amphora Hall, the Coin Section, the Icon Hall and the garden exhibition. The museum garden houses; the Temple of Serapis, the tomb of lady with mirror and Sinop Monument of sea martyrs.
